Data Privacy Day is celebrated every January 28

Recognized by students, teachers, academics, privacy professionals, businesses, and government officials around the world, **Data Privacy Day** highlights the impact that technology is having on our privacy rights and underscores the importance of valuing and protecting personal information.

First celebrated in Canada and the United States in January 2008 (and earlier in Europe), the day commemorates the January 28, 1981, signing of Convention 108, the first legally binding international treaty dealing with privacy and data protection.

- Share privacy tips and resources with your classmates, friends and family.
- Write and share online posts or articles about the importance of privacy protection.
- Host a student forum to hear speakers on the subject.
- Participate in a poster or video contest.
